Footnotes

DID broke sharply, opened a commanding advantage racing to the bend and held sway to the end under pressure. DEPUTY TICE chased the pacesetter racing three wide to the lane, but proved no match for the winner. STAR COURT raced unhurried outside foes on the backstretch, advanced four wide on the turn and into the lane to make some mild progress late. MR. SADDLER tracked the pacesetter between foes to the turn but faded after a half. BETYOURBRITCHES was outpaced early, angled inside nearing the turn but never reached contention. CITY NUMBER was off awkwardly and never menaced thereafter. BRIAN'S REPRIZED flashed brief pace along the inside but gave way after the opening quarter. SIR REGENT was never a factor.
