**Footnotes**

CACHEMASSA CREEK vied for the early lead outside, gained a short lead into the second turn, dueled with SLEEK JOHN through the lane and held. SLEEK JOHN mid pack and inside, moved up through the second turn, angled out slightly to bid between, dueled with the winner and hung. HEAVENLY DUE well back and off the rail, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, bid widest into the stretch and closed well. GIN STINGER well back and off the rail, moved up on the two path through the second turn and weakened the final furlong. CODE RUNNER passed tiring rivals. MACK'S MONARCH well placed and three wide, challenged into the stretch and faded. SWEET FLEET FEET set the early pace inside and was through after a half. RYLEE RIVER was never involved. THE QUINSTER was a brief factor and was outrun.
