MISS LACY SHEA secured a stalking position in the opening stages, made a steady advance on the first flight racing into the turn, came out to wrest command four wide nearing upper stretch, then went clear through the lane under steady encouragement. DANCER'S PROSPECT tracked the leaders outside rivals in the second flight, made some progress to secure second in the drive but was never gaining terms with the winner. CULLEY, allowed to settle in the opening quarter, angled off the inside racing into the lane and continued to improve position. CENTER POINT BLAZE was a bit outpaced early and passed some tiring rivals in the stretch. MORE THAN GOLDEN broke sharply, prompted the pace racing three wide to the lane and gave way. ELUSIVE WOLF vied for command between foes and gave way in the drive. VICTORIOUS VICKI was rated along the inside on the backstretch, saved ground to the lane but lacked the needed late response. ROSE N ANGELINA was hustled up the inside from the break, dueled for command along the rail to upper stretch and stopped abruptly.
