BLUMIN LUCKY saved ground tracking the pace along the inside, began to pick up the pace nearing the far turn, angled out at the top of the lane and dug in four wide in the deep stretch to prevail. DEMIS NATIVEDANCER broke inward at the start, dueled for the lead with JUMPIN JIMINEYS in the backstretch, continued to battle into the stretch, continued to dig in but could not hold off late challenger in final strides. JUMPIN JIMINEYS vied with DEMIS NATIVEDANCER in the backstretch, continued to match strides into the stretch and could not keep up the pace in final furlong. L G SUPREM stalked the pace in early stages, raced two wide in the far turn and finished evenly in the drive. DEMIS LIL' STAR saved ground racing along the inside and improved position in the stretch. TWO CHANCE made a bid in early stages and steadily weakened after half. STORMY LEDGER away slowly at the start and failed to rally. RUN TREVOR RUN raced two to three wide and was no threat.
