Footnotes

CRIMSON VIEW was sent clear racing into the first turn, dictated the pace to the far bend, shook off a rival's bend nearing upper stretch and held sway to the end under strong urging. MOONING YOU stalked the pacesetter along the inside as part of the second flight to the far turn, then continued willingly inside foes through the lane to prove second best. SMOKE BABY, reserved inside foes in the opening half, angled off the inside approaching the far turn commencing his rally, then came through close quarters entering the lane to secure third late. HEAP WAMPUM tracked the pace between foes unhurried to the backstretch, angled out entering upper stretch and continued with a mild bid. WICKLOW GATE, caught four wide entering the first turn, continued outside foes to the far turn but lacked the needed late response. BEAT YOUR BLUFF exchanged solid contact with WHO'S HUSSONET at the start, was righted to track between foes off the second flight, lodged a brief bid nearing upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. POWERFUL PEPPER was reserved off rivals for a half, then passed inside tiring foes in the final stages. MOSQUITO COAST tracked off the second flight along the inside to the far turn, then steadily faded in the drive. WHO'S HUSSONET exchanged solid bumps with BEAT YOUR BLUFF at the start and never menaced thereafter. SOMERSET SAM, close up three wide in early stages, made a brief bid after a half, then emptied out in the drive.
