Footnotes

CEJKA broke sharply, dictated the pace along the rail racing into the bend, went clear in upper stretch and just lasted. LAUNCH LIGHT tracked just out of striking distance along the inside early, moved to gain terms with the second flight while angling out sharply midway through the turn, continued to drift out through the lane but closed the gap to the end and was just outnodded. RATON PASS, shuffled in traffic at the start, was settled outside foes early, swung six wide in upper stretch and continued to make mild progress. BET YOUR BOOTS, bumped at the start, was collected to track just outside the second flight early, raced five wide through the turn and weakened in the drive. RUBY'S BIG BAND broke out, bumped BET YOUR BOOTS, was righted to chase the pace between foes but steadily weakened nearing the lane. GAMBLIN' JERRY chased the leader racing four wide to the turn and steadily weakened in the drive. RUSTIC ROAD chased the pacesetter near the inside as part of the second flight, was shut off by LAUNCH LIGHT midway through the bend, steadied off that foe and lost all momentum. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE INCIDENT ON THE TURN AND DISQUALIFIED LAUNCH LIGHT FOR INTERFERENCE, PLACING HIM LAST.
