FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. Free to nominate, \$250 to pass the entry box and \$250 additional to start, with \$50,000 guaranteed, of which \$30,000 guaranteed to the owner of the winner. All other purse monies paid corresponding with purse schedule in Condition Book. Weights: Three-year-olds, 116 lbs; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$18,000 at one mile or over in 2009 allowed 3 lbs; \$15,000 in 2009, 5 lbs; \$12,000 in 2008-2009, 7 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in allowances).HIGH WEIGHTS PREFERRED. (On the scale). (Winners Preferred). Total earnings in 2008-2009 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Thursday, July 30 with 33. (If management deems it inadvisable to run this race on the Turf, it will be run at a distance of 1 Mile and 1/16 on the main track.) (Rail at 10 feet).

Footnotes

TRYING BRIAN sped clear of the field into the first turn, dictated the pace on a clear lead to upper stretch, then held the challenge of PURSUE A DREAM under firm handling. The latter tracked the leader along the inside as part of the second flight, made steady progress leaving the far turn to bid inside the pacesetter but came up second best. GILDED LEADER, held up between foes in early stages, angled out a bit on the far turn, split foes in upper stretch and continued well enough to secure a share. ALPHA CAPO, bumped at the start, was reserved outside a rival racing to the backstretch, shifted out nearing upper stretch and split foes with a belated effort. ORIENTATE EXPRESS led the second flight from between foes to the backstretch, lodged a brief bid outside the pacesetter entering the far turn but quickly flattened out. CANARD was settled saving ground and never gained striking distance. HEZA WILD GUY broke in, bumped ALPHA CAPO, was righted to track outside rivals as part of the second flight but came up empty in the drive. SPIDER POWER (IRE) never seriously menaced. CAPE SAN BLAS tracked the leaders off the inside, made some brief progress outside foes on the backstretch but quickly faded from contention on the far turn.
