CUZAN showed quick speed at the start, vied along the inside of FUSAICHI KID in the backstretch, continued to match strides at the top of the lane, battled gamely into deep stretch, hit left handed nearing the eighth pole, slightly brushed into foe and kept on. FUSAICHI KID showed early speed and dueled along the outside of CUZAN, they continued to match strides gamely into the stretch, brushed slightly by foe near eighth pole, kept on battled to the wire. DOUBLE ZAP tracked the pace in early stages, steadily picked up the pace leaving the backstretch, swung out five wide in far turn and gained ground to be up for show. ITALIAN MONARCH raced three wide in the far turn and lacked late needed kick in the drive. SHARP RICHARD stalked the pace along the inside and came up empty in the stretch. CHIEF ENGINEER lacked response throughout. After a jockeys claim of foal and stewards inquiry #5 CUZAN was disqualified from first and placed second for interference with #6 FUSAICHI KID in the deep stretch.
