Footnotes

STORMY DAISY tracked the first flight unhurried through the backstretch, angled inwards nearing the turn while gaining striking distance, bid for command along the rail nearing mid stretch and prevailed late under pressure. EUREKA VALENTINE dueled for command along the inside from the break, continued grudgingly to late stages while drifting off the rail a bit and just missed. FIT TO CUT prompted the pace between foes into the turn, dueled for command to the last sixteenth but was outfinished by the top pair. MAJESTIC ALLIANCE was off a step slowly, switched off the rail to track the leaders and improved position her position in late stages. THEOAKPORTDUCHESS was reserved a bit in early stages and never gained striking position. PAGING JOI stalked just off and outside the first flight, pressed the pace four wide on the turn and gave way in upper stretch. CHASING THE DREAM was guided to the rail in early stages, saved ground to the lane but never seriously menaced. MINNESOTA PROSPECT, prominent three wide from the outset while in hand, made a brief bid between foes on the turn but gave way after a half.
