(A supplementary nomination of \$3,000 may be made at the time of entry which includes entry and starting fees.) With \$75,000 guaranteed (includes \$35,000 from Mystic Lake Purse Enhancement Fund with the balance to include nominations, entry and starting fees) of which \$45,000 to the owner of the winner. All other purse monies paid corresponding with purse schedule in Condition Book. WEIGHT: 122 lbs. Maidens allowed 5 lbs. HIGH WEIGHTS PREFERRED. (WINNERS PREFERRED).

(Non-starters least preferred). Total earnings will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Monday, April 1, 2013 with 37 nominations. (S)

Footnotes

BADGE OF GLORY vied for the lead in the opening quarter, in tight along the rail near the three eighths, checked sharply, briefly lost momentum, recovered and edged way back up near lead, battled with SWEET TANGO into far turn, shook free in upper stretch, steadily increased margin, began to tire in the final furlong, dug back in and prevailed. SWEET TANGO dueled with BADGE OF GLORY going into the first turn, drifted in slightly near the three eighths pole causing rival to check, took the lead, challenged again by BADGE OF SILVER, dueled with rival into the far turn, could not match strides in the upper stretch and kept on after rival in late drive. B J'S ANGEL raced just off the top two leaders in the backstretch, raced three to four wide in the far turn and continued a steady bid for top two in the drive. SILVER SOMERSET lacked speed in early stages and raced near the back of rivals, steadily began to pick up the pace nearing the far turn, raced three to four wide and improved position in the drive. BROOKE ACADEMY stalked the pace two wide in the backstretch, saved ground racing along the inside in the far turn and lacked late needed kick to make an impact. SULTRY QUEEN settled in and stalked the leaders in the backstretch, arced three wide in the far turn and came up empty in the drive. CITY KID saved ground racing along the inside and failed to threaten in the stretch. ADORKABLE was away awkwardly at the start, settled in and stalked the pace in early stages, briefly improved position and faded at the top of the lane. LUCKY LOOP stalked the pace near the inside in backstretch and had nothing left in the stretch. BABY PICKLES raced five wide in the first turn,

dropped back to last after opening quarter and eased up in the stretch.
