Footnotes

NEVERS TRUMP CARD angled to the rail soon after the break, forced the pace inside a rival on the backstretch, edged forward of that foe in the lane and held her advantage in a prolonged drive. RIX MISS TRIX was hustled to the front while angling inwards a bit to join the winner, dueled with that rival to the lane, but proved second best in the drive. MIDNIGHT MOVER was forwardly placed saving ground in the opening stages, angled outside the first flight to challenge in upper stretch and gradually closed the gap in the final furlong. ACAROIDS ONCORE was under a pull early, tracked the pace along the rail, made a bid into the stretch along the inside to make a mild, late gain. MISS TWO BAGGER, allowed to settle well off foes, made some progress to gain a contending position on the far turn, angled five wide into the lane but could make no further impact. CAFE DE FRANCE settled in the early stages, offered no rally. ROSETTA L. angled inwards a bit, stalked just off the leaders three wide for six furlongs, then faded nearing the lane. JOUNIEH BAY raced under stout restraint into the first turn and never gained contention.
