Non-winners of \$15,000 at one mile or over in 2002 allowed 3 lbs; \$12,000 in 2002, 5 lbs; \$10,000 in 2001-2002, 7 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in allowances). HIGH WEIGHTS PREFERRED (On the scale). Total earnings in 2001-2002 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to 12 horses. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. NOMINATIONS CLOSE AUGUST 1.



BE MY FRIEND responded when asked to secure the lead, dropped over once clear of her foes approaching the first bend, dictated the tempo while well within herself, was roused in upper stretch to fend off the challenge of SARAH JADE and just held that foe under brisk handling. The latter was taken in hand just after the start while securing a forward placing, stalked just off the pacesetter to the far turn, shifted out sharply entering upper stretch, closed the gap in the drive but came up second best. PICNIC SPREAD, reserved outside a rival in the second flight, angled three wide in upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the top pair despite stout pressure and just held third. LOOK TO THE DAY raced unhurried off the inside to the backstretch, split foes to improve her position midway through the far turn and was outfinished for third in the drive. RENAISSANCE FAIR broke inwards and was steadied a bit just after the start, was collected to race in reserve along the rail, came through tight quarters in upper stretch to improve her placing but made no impression on the leaders. HAM AND EGGS broke sharply, was held up off the pace while saving ground to the backstretch, continued under stout restraint for five furlongs, then dropped out of contention nearing the lane. MOONLIT MADDIE was reserved well off the pace to the backstretch, swung five wide entering the lane but lacked any further rally.
