PROGRAM MANAGER broke out at the start, tracked the early pace inside, raced boxed through the second turn, angled around a tiring rival, angled back in and got through inside of rivals into the stretch, then drew off under steady pressure. CHIEF INTRUDER stalked the early pace to the outside, gained a clear lead into the stretch, then could not go with the winner but stayed on to hold the place safe. SKIP THE HATCHET mid pack and inside, angled out through the second turn to loop rivals three wide, bid on that path into the stretch, then could not gain the final furlong. TIGERSTARK void of speed and off the rail, bid six wide into the stretch and got up for a share. TORI'S BOLDONE well back, moved up on the rail through the second turn, angled out and bid five wide into the stretch, drifted out and weakened. SCOREBOARD set the pace on a long lead and faltered. EASY PLUNDER showed little. ONE NICE COPY CAT was outrun, outside.
