HIGH SPIRIT mid pack and inside, gained a striking position on the two path through the second turn, came three wide to bid into the stretch, then made a steady gain and edged ahead in the final strides. JAIVAL mid pack and outside, moved up three wide through the second turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch, then made a steady gain and was outfinished. SLEW CITY STORM sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, turned back a challenge into the stretch, then drifted out and weakened late. CARNERA tracked the early pace off the rail lugging out, moved up to challenge into the stretch, then faded. GUTS improved his position, inside. MISTER MERZ well placed and off the rail, steadily faded. TRUMPER was never involved. LUVINI' GEORGE was through after a half and was outrun.
