Footnotes

FLAG LADY B joined the pace between foes in the opening quarter, dueled along the rail through the turn, then edged clear in late stages under a strong drive. FAREWELL TO ARMS (GB), forwardly placed from the break, pressed the pace outside a rival racing into the turn, dueled to midstretch and was outfinished. BLACK TEJANO, unhurried tracking the pace in early stages, made a mild gain along the inside racing into the lane. CHASE'N CAMMIE tracked the leaders in second flight, advanced to challenge three wide nearing upper stretch but quickly flattened out. DEVIOUS DAME tracked the pace between foes on the backstretch, angled four wide leaving the turn to briefly challenge but failed to sustain her bid. THIS DAY IS MINE never seriously menaced. URN AND ASHES was hustled to the front but was spent after the opening quarter. COQ D' OR trailed, was soon outdistanced and walked off under her own power.
