DANNAGAN joined the pace between foes in the opening stages, lost some position to the leaders nearing upper stretch, angled out racing through the lane while producing a second effort and just edged BUCA PRIMO on the wire to prevail under stout pressure. The latter broke readily, angled inside disputing the pace, resisted several challenges to edge forward leaving midstretch but was just outnodded on the wire. SOUNDS GOOD, bumped at the break by FREEDOM FIRST, continued a bit erratically stalking just off the leaders, bid three for command on the turn, lugged in entering upper stretch and couldn't match terms with the top pair late. FREEDOM FIRST broke out, bumped a rival, was righted to track the leaders along the rail to upper stretch and continued evenly in late stages. JAIVAL broke in, bumped LIPPY REMARK, was righted to track the pace off the inside and made some belated progress racing through the stretch. LIPPY REMARK, bumped at the start, never gained contention. TELPERION never seriously menaced.
