JOST VAN DYKE stalked the early pace three wide, moved up to challenge for and gain a short lead through the turn, gained a clear lead in the stretch, then drew off under mild urging. CUBFANBUDMAN never far back and outside, looped rivals three wide through the turn, bid on that path into the stretch, then could not threaten the winner while clearly best of the rest. ERV THE BANKER tracked the early pace on the inside, gained a striking position through the turn, then could not gain on the top two through the lane while holding the show safe. MISSNORASDOUBLE passed a tiring rival. LOCAL BIG SHOT sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, could not go with the winner through the turn and had no stretch rally. DIXIE BUCK was never involved, outside.
