Footnotes

SMOKIN AFFAIR broke sharply, took up a stalking position just off and outside the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, steadily closed the gap on that rival leaving the second turn, bid three deep for command leaving the furlong marker, drifted inwards late but prevailed under brisk handling. CLASSY CON, caught in tight quarters at the break, was allowed to settle off the leaders while angling to the rail, advanced to contention along the inside entering the far turn, challenged inside the pacesetter in tandem with the winner nearing the furlong grounds but proved second best in the drive. SKY COUNTRY raced unhurried saving ground to the backstretch, then made an effort to improve her position in the latter stages. CASEYS CALL, a bit fractious in the gate, sprinted clear of her rivals into the first turn, made the pace to upper stretch and gave way leaving the furlong marker. CARLA SPARKLES, devoid of early speed, never gained striking position. CANDY CANE DELIGHT was rated just off the inside to the backstretch but couldn't produce the necessary closing bid. SUMMIT RIDGE tracked the leaders racing off the inside to the backstretch and gave way after a half.
