Footnotes

JUST A NIBBLE sprinted clear of the field while angling to the inside, dictated the pace to the far turn, then turned back his rivals entering upper stretch to prevail under firm handling. ONOTHEREGOSTOKYO was allowed to settle outside foes in the opening half, rallied to striking distance leaving the far turn, split foes three wide entering upper stretch and continued well enough to secure the place. FIZZY POP tracked the pacesetter off the inside racing three deep to the far turn, was fanned four wide entering upper stretch but continued willingly for a share. ROADSTER settled along the inside early and made some mild progress racing into the lane. LITTLE WAGON stalked just off the pacesetter near the inside, bid for command nearing upper stretch but flattened in the drive. TRUMPER tracked the leaders off the inside to the far turn and steadily faded nearing the lane. CAPTAIN BUCKY was reserved along the inside early and offered no rally. BENSON dropped out early.
