LUVIN' GEORGE stalked the early pace three wide, moved up to loop rivals on that path through the second turn, challenged for and gained a clear lead into the stretch, then drew off and held. ERV THE BANKER well placed and inside, angled out through the second turn to bid three wide into the stretch, closed well to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. VINCENT CAN GO vied for the early lead outside, gained a short lead mid way of the second turn, then could not go with the winner, stayed on and held the show safe. DANDY LONGLEGS passed a tiring rival. DA HAWG set the pace inside and faded after a half. DOS ANGELS WARRIOR trailed the field.
