### Footnotes

JAIVAL mid pack and outside, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, bid on that path into the stretch, then drew off while being kept to the task. READY TO ROLL stalked the early pace outside, bid just outside the pace setter while in a striking position, then could not gain the final furlong. PALMAS DEL MAR set the early pace on a clear lead, stayed on through the lane to hold the show safe. TRUMPER had a rail trip and got up for a share. SOUNDS GOOD rated nicely on the rail, moved to a striking position through the second turn, then had no rally. MR. DOFF was never involved. SPECTACULAR DEMI tracked the pace inside and faded nearing the lane.
