### Footnotes

I GROW ON YOU tracked the leaders in hand while saving ground through the first turn, was guided to the outside midway through the backstretch commencing a rally, made steady progress four wide on the second turn to gain terms with the pacesetter, then edged that foe under strong handling in the closing stages. SANDY'S SPECIAL was hustled to the front from outside rivals, dropped over midway through the first turn, repelled a challenge from several foes entering the far turn, forged clear leaving that bend but couldn't fend off the winner's last bid. SCRATCH AGAIN tracked off and outside the leaders to the backstretch, worked his way to the inside approaching the far turn to bid between rivals, exchanged some brushes with VIVID LYNNE nearing the quarter pole, came out to challenge the top pair in the lane and closed the gap late. VIVID LYNNE broke sharply, stalked the pacesetter along the rail to the backstretch, made some progress in that path entering the far turn, exchanged some brushes with SCRATCH AGAIN nearing the quarter pole, steadied off that rival and soon and gave way. TINKER WITH TIME, reserved to the backstretch, gradually gained terms with the field entering the far turn, angled five wide racing into the lane but was never a serious factor. BLUSHING JABAR broke inwards, bumped MISS TWO BAGGER, came around foes on the first turn to join the pace, pressed the pace three deep to the far turn and gave way. MISS TWO BAGGER, bumped at the start, settled off the leaders to the backstretch, came out four wide racing into the lane but proved no menace. TACEY came in racing into the first turn, chased the pacesetter between foes to the far turn, steadied in traffic midway through the far turn and quickly gave way.
