MCKENNA BEACH bobbled at the start, quickly recovered and secured a clear advantage racing just off the inside, dictated the tempo while steadily widening her margin into the turn and pulled away under steady encouragement. NEUMANNS CAT broke sharply, chased the pacesetter into the turn, soon proved no match for that foe but was clearly best of the others. PRIOR LAKE LADY was switched off the inside tracking the top pair but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. DIAMONDSAREFOREVER broke slowly, saved ground to the lane and came inside foes improving her position in the final stages. MRS. BEERMAN was caught four wide between foes tracking the leaders and weakened steadily racing through the turn. NILINI was outpaced early and never seriously menaced. SARASWATIE, off a step slowly, tracked the leaders three wide between foes and faded from contention early. PILOTS LAST FLIGHT tracked the leaders five wide to the turn and dropped out.
