SEENEMONNA T. V., bumped at the start by OUR LUCKY DRAW, was collected and raced outside foes under light rating for a half, made a steady advance while four wide approaching the far turn to gain striking position, then continued resolutely through the lane to edge TOKYO TOUR in the final stages under firm handling. The latter was sent to the lead inside rivals, dictated the pace to the far turn, briefly shook clear leaving the second bend but couldn't sustain her momentum through the final sixteenth. TUSCANY BAY tracked the leaders off the inside to the backstretch, then made an effort to improve her position late. IRISH ACCENT reserved near the inside in the opening stages, passed some tiring rivals racing into the lane. OUR LUCKY DRAW ducked out and bumped the winner at the start, was hustled three deep into the backstretch to force the pace and gave way on the far turn. NEILY BOP, unhurried saving ground to the backstretch, steadily faded after a half. THREE MINDS, forwardly placed between foes from the outset, attended the pace for a half, then dropped out on the far turn.
