Footnotes

BUDDY'S MISSILE, forwardly placed from the outset, pressed outside a rival into upper stretch, took over leaving the furlong marker and held safe J T KINGFISHER under steady pressure. The latter raced unhurried saving ground to the backstretch, switched out to split foes three deep entering upper stretch, drew on terms with the winner late but was always best. NO REVENGE raced unhurried in early stages, advanced four on the backstretch to press outside the leaders approaching the far turn but flattened out late. GHAZARINO was urged to the lead along the inside in the opening stages, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way late. O. G. HUNTER was settled outside a rival and never gained contention. LONE SKY was a brief factor along the inside and emptied out after a half. METTS READY flashed brief pace between foes and was spent after a half.
