FOR COLTS AND GELDINGS, TWO YEARS OLD WHICH ARE REGISTERED MINNESOTA BREDS. By subscription of a \$200 nomination on or before April 2, 2008. Late nomination fee: \$500 by June 1, 2008. \$300 to pass the entry box and \$300 additional to start. A supplementary nomination of \$3,000 may be made at the time of entry which includes entry and starting fees. With \$60,000 guaranteed (\$28,000 from Canterbury Park and \$15,000 from the Minnesota Breeders' Fund with the balance to include nominations, entry and starting fees), of which \$36,000 to the owner of the winner. All other purse monies paid corresponding with purse schedule in Condition Book. WEIGHT: 120 lbs. Maidens allowed 3 lbs. WINNERS PREFERRED. (Non-starters least preferred). Total earnings will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to 12 horses. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A portion of the nomination fees may be retained by the MTA for nomination expenses. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

**Footnotes**

ICE ROCKET was settled along the inside in the opening stages, swung out midway through the turn while under prompting to gain contention, was fanned wide in upper stretch but continued to respond to stout pressure to wrest command and edge clear in the final sixteenth. SUPREME WARRIOR, prominent along the rail from the outset, pressed inside a rival for command racing into the turn, gained brief command leaving midstretch but couldn't fend off the winner. FIRST CAPTAIN stalked just off and outside the first flight, bid three wide for command racing into upper stretch but couldn't sustain his momentum. ZACK CAPE shifted inwards at the start exchanging bumps with YAPPAH DO, angled inwards chasing the leaders into the bend and emptied out after a half. A STEEL TRAP hesitated, then bobbed at the start while losing his path, was urged to regain contention racing into the bend, loomed four wide in upper stretch but flattened out. LUMPSINMYOATMEAL was allowed to settle in early stages and passed some tiring rivals in the drive. YAPPAH DO broke in, exchanged bumps with ZACK CAPE, was righted to force the pace outside a rival racing to the turn and gave way in upper stretch. NOT SO FAST FESTUS tracked the pace unhurried outside foes to the turn but never gained striking distance. LEADING TEMPTATION dropped out early. WET STONE was never a factor.
