Non-winners of \$15,000 twice at one mile or over in 2013, allowed 3 lbs; \$15,000 at a mile or over in 2013, 5 lbs; \$10,000 at a mile or over in 2012-2013, 7 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in allowance.) HIGH WEIGHTS PREFERRED. ((On the scale). (Winners preferred). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Thursday, August 8, 2013 with 24 nominations. (If management deems it inadvisable to run this race on the Turf, it will be run at a distance of 1 Mile and 1/16 on the main track.) (Rail at 10 feet).

STARRY EYED KATE raced just off the leader in opening stages and pressed the early pace, continued to pull along the rail, edged up to the lead nearing the far turn, vied along the inside of rivals, shook free at the top of the lane and held off late charging rival in final strides. GRANDMA'S RULES well placed in early stages settled in along the inside, asked to pick up the pace nearing the far turn, angled out slightly at the top of the lane, finished willingly and just missed at the wire. LILY THE PINK pressed the pace in early stages, edged up to the lead, vied three deep in the far turn, could not match strides at the top of the lane, kept on and held show. QUINICHETTE took command by slight margin in opening quarter, challenged and vied between rivals going into the far turn, could not keep up the pace and steadily weakened. LADY HADDASSAH was reserved in early stages, asked to pick up the pace along the outside in the far turn and failed to respond. CELL LINE FOREVER saved ground racing along the inside and failed to be a threat. DINA'S TYPHOON showed little throughout.
