Footnotes

LEAWOOD broke sharply, dictated the tempo to the far turn, then gamely held her rivals under firm handling through the lane. STARLET SKY stalked the pacesetter along the inside, angled out in upper stretch to challenge between foes and won the nod for second. LEGENDARY SMILE, reserved in early stages, advanced along the inside racing through the far turn, angled out making steady progress in late stages and just missed second. SKYLINE GAL angled inwards racing to the first bend, tracked the pacesetter outside a foe, bid for command racing into the lane but weakened when proving no match. V'VILLE LADY was held up outside foes racing to the backstretch but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. FRENCH FERN (IRE), unhurried along the inside, never mounted a serious challenge. WINE AND SPIRITS tracked the leaders three deep to the backstretch, then emptied out on the far turn.
