Footnotes

BRAVO PRADO sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, increased his margin, then lasted while all out. BEAT YOUR BLUFF tracked the pace just off the rail, angled out through the second turn to bid three wide, then closed fast in the lane and missed. TYMAKER well placed and three wide, moved up and bid just outside the pace setter, then lacked the needed late kick. BLAST'EM well back, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, bid on that path into the stretch, then closed well through the lane to get up for a share. ERV THE BANKER mid pack, moved up on the two path through the second turn, split foes in the lane and ran evenly the final furlong. GOLD COUNTRY CAT mid pack and outside, moved up on the two path through the second turn, came three wide to bid and ran evenly in the lane. BRAX ran evenly. MELBAS SLEW showed little. BALLETT WAY was never involved. BRAVE LITTLE BULL was no factor.
