FILLE FILLY FIFI, brushed at the break by SMOOTH SHANNON, recovered quickly, saved ground into the first turn while stalking the leaders, made a steady advance to join the first flight, came off the rail midway through the far turn to challenge in upper stretch, then pulled clear in the lane under steady right handed pressure. COULEUR DE ROSE sped to the front while angling to the rail, set the pace for six furlong while edging clear leaving the far turn, resisted the winner when challenged, but came up second best. SMOOTH SHANNON broke in a bit brushing the winner, tracked the pace in the second flight, drifted out on the first turn, advanced to a forward position nearing the far turn, bid three wide on that bend but proved no match for the top two. BAYNETTEBABA tracked outside the leaders into the first turn, was forced out by SMOOTH SHANNON on the turn, recovered to make a late challenge outside foes, then finished evenly through the lane. REBAS RECKONING angled inwards to track just off the pacesetter in the opening stages and faded steadily leaving the far turn. MISS TWO BAGGER was reserved on the inside and offered no rally. DIABLOSANGELEYES tracked the pace three wide early and gave way nearing the far turn. MAUDLINS DIAMOND, allowed to settle along the rail, steadied off rivals racing into the backstretch and soon lost contact.
