Footnotes

BER BEAR broke sharply, attended the pace outside a rival, shook clear entering upper stretch and widened his advantage under steady pressure. STAR SEA joined the pace inside the winner, dueled with that one into upper stretch and proved second best. A SPLASH OF TOUR tracked the leaders along the inside to the lane and improved his position in late stages. U WANT SOMA DIS stalked just outside the leaders racing three wide into the bend, then weakened in the drive. SNEAKIN BY tracked the pace between foes and continued evenly into the lane. RED SPIDER tracked the pace outside rivals but never gained contention. ST. SIMON'S LOVE never seriously menaced. I'MALITTLEBITLUCKY was a brief factor racing along the inside but faded steadily from contention. DOUBLE SNOW was never a factor. HEFFERMAN ducked in at the start and lost his rider.
