GHOST DANCE well placed and outside, pulled to contention three wide through the second turn, bid on that path into the stretch, then made a steady gain, edged ahead and held. PRIVATE WARRIOR well placed and inside, gained a striking position through the second turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, gained a short lead and was outfinished. JACK'S TIGER mid pack and inside, gained position through the second turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, then angled out late for clear racing room and exchanged bumps and could not gain. HERE COMES HENRY well back and inside, moved up through the second turn, came four wide to bid, then drifted in through the lane, exchanged bumps late and missed the show. SUPREMO STRUCKGOLD stalked the early pace inside, moved up through the second turn on the two path, bid three wide into the stretch, then lost his path the final furlong and ran evenly. SUE'S STORMY sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start while pulling, then faded. SHEER TRICK void of speed, moved up through the second turn, fanned widest into the stretch, then drifted in and had no rally. THE QUINNSTER lost contact with the field and was eased over the wire. A STEWARS' INQUIRY INTO THE RUNNING OF THE RACE TOOK NO ACTION.
