**Footnotes**

TACO DON was urged to gain a contending position in the second flight racing along the inside in the opening stages, shifted outside the pacesetter to challenge that foe entering upper stretch, wrested command nearing the furlong marker, then gamely held the challenge of WHO LET THE CAT IN under firm encouragement. The latter, unhurried in early stages tracking just off the inside, angled out four wide entering upper stretch, then steadily closed the gap on the pacesetter to the end but came up second best. JUSTA STREAK, bumped at the start by SAX NOTES, was settled into stride, split foes racing into upper stretch and continued to improve his position to the end. BOLD TRUST tracked the pacesetter between foes in the second flight, couldn't maintain terms with the winner but continued evenly to late stages. AFICIONADO tracked the pace outside foes from just out of striking distance early but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. BETTER MAKE MONEY was allowed to settle in early stages but never gained striking distance. HUMBLE SMARTY tracked the pacesetter racing three wide in second flight to the turn, then retreated steadily from contention. CRY ME NO RIVER was hustled to the lead, set the pace for a half and gave way abruptly. SAX NOTES broke out, bumped a rival, was settled between foes and offered no rally.
