### Footnotes

ABOUNDING APTITUDE chased the early pace inside, moved up and angled out through the second turn, bid just outside the pace setter, drew off in the lane under brisk handling. SIBERIAN PUNCH mid pack and off the rail, moved up through the second turn, bid three wide into the stretch, then closed willingly but could not threaten the winner. ADRISA void of speed and inside, fanned widest into the stretch, then closed willingly and got up for the show in the final strides. STREET HAVEN well placed and outside, moved up on the two path through the second turn, then could not gain in the late going. COURAGEOUS CAREY improved his position. RUSSIAN REPRIEVE ran evenly. PIOUS PETE showed little. FLATNOTE set the pace on a long lead while pulling and stopped. MENAGHA lost contact with the field.
