Footnotes

HEART'S OF GOLD sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, turned back a challenge into the stretch, shook clear and lasted. HOLLY IN APRIL well placed three wide, moved up to bid just outside the pace, then weakened the final furlong. GYPSY MELODY tracked the early pace inside, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, altered out for clear racing room, then drifted out bumped a rival and flattened out. SOL FIRE well back and off the rail, moved up on the two path through the turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. PROUD KYLEAN well placed and outside, moved up three wide through the turn, bid on that path into the stretch, was bumped by a rival inside the furlong marker and faded. SOMERSET BALLERINA never far back and outside, looped rivals three wide through the turn, came widest into the stretch and weakened. APPEALING ZEPHYR stumbled at the start, was no factor. AMY'S TEARS was never involved. SOUPER FOUR was a brief factor.
