Footnotes

BIG STICK tracked the early pace inside, split rivals to gain a clear lead into the second turn, then drew off in the lane and was kept to the task. DON'T BLUFF mid pack and inside, gained a striking position through the second turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch, then made a steady gain and got up for the place in the final strides. SWEETTALK'N JUNIOR set the early pace outside, could not go with the winner through the second turn, stayed on and weakened the final furlong. ILIKECHOCOLATEMILK well back and inside, moved up on the rail through the second turn, split foes into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. VICTORY CHECK well back and outside, passed tiring rivals. YACHT SPOTTER well placed and outside, moved up through the second turn to bid four wide into the stretch and ran evenly. MACK'S MONARCH stalked the early pace three wide, dropped back into the second turn and faded. HAITIAN was no factor. FLEET CAVALRY was never involved. SUBTLE HUNTER vied for the early lead inside and was through after a half. JONI'S JUSTICE reared at the start and lost the rider.
