Footnotes

LOBO COUNTRY, prominent between foes from the outset, was held up just off the leaders entering the first turn, stalked just off those foes to the far turn, made steady progress to challenge outside a rival nearing upper stretch, drifted out markedly under left handed pressure in the final stages but grimly held the challenge of SINGLE BARREL to prevail. The latter worked his way to the inside while tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance, made a steady advance to contention leaving the far turn, shifted off the rail leaving the furlong marker to split foes and just missed. EL INTOCHABLE, bumped at the start, was quickly collected, then urged to the fore, dueled for command along the rail to midstretch but couldn't quite match terms with the top pair late. BERUDENOTTOO, carried out a bit racing into the first turn by TEXAS ROSE, tracked the pace unhurried to the backstretch, advanced outside foes to gain contention leaving the far turn but had no final response. LAFOLLETTE, allowed to settle along the inside to the backstretch, passed tiring rivals in the final three furlongs. TEXAS ROSE ducked out at the start bumping EL INTOCHABLE, drifted out into a rival's path racing into the first turn and never menaced thereafter. PROSPECT GEM joined the pace three wide racing into the first turn, prompted the pace outside a rival to the far turn and gave way. EQUUS GABRELUS was pulled up on the backstretch and vanned off the course.
