PATRIATE set the pace by a slight margin in the backstretch, continued to lead by a slight margin at the top of the lane, dug in gamely in deep stretch to prevail. NO TEAM SPIRIT settled in and stalked the pacesetters in early stages, slipped through along the rail in the upper stretch and held on to place at the wire. HEIR JOE reserved in the backstretch, saved ground along the rail in the far turn and quickly gained ground in the deep stretch. HARD NOSED settled in and stalked the early front runners, made a bid in the upper stretch, gained ground and yielded in late strides. THE FLYING WHIZZER raced just off the early pace and had came up empty at the top of the lane. SUGAR STORM raced just off the leader in the backstretch and steadily faded going into the far turn. DESERT PRIZE tracked the pace in the backstretch and had nothing left in the drive.
