Footnotes

SASS raced unhurried off the inside in the opening half, made a steady advance to contention three deep on the far turn, took over leaving midstretch and held METRO MOLLY safe under firm encouragement. The latter held up along the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out to split foes entering upper stretch and secured the place in the drive. PRETTY LITTLE ANNA, reserved along the inside in the opening half, angled four wide entering upper stretch and made some progress for a share. BUCKIN' OUTRIGHT, forwardly placed along the inside from the break, stalked a rival on the backstretch, advanced to challenge nearing upper stretch but had no final response. SUNDAY QUEEN stalked just outside the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, then came up empty on the far turn. MISS BULLY, unprepared for the start, shifted outside rivals while being urged to the lead, held brief command after a half but was quickly used up.
