ROYAL EXPRESS set the pace on the inside, shook clear through the turn, drew off in the lane and kept while being kept to the task. TIMETOBOOK tracked the pace inside, angled out to bid just outside that one, then could match strides with the winner through the lane and held the place safe. SEATTLE SAL well back, moved up through the turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, angled to the rail and closed willingly to get up for the show while no threat to the top two. AFLEET INDY well placed and outside, gained a striking position through the turn, came four wide to bid and weakened in the drive. LAST BASKET vied for the early lead outside and faded. AT THE BRINK was no factor. RECAST was never involved.
