Footnotes

MOUNT STEPNEY took command at the start, continued to set the pace in the backstretch, challenged by CONTACT in the far turn, took back command and continued clear to the wire. CONTACT tracked the pacesetter along the inside in the backstretch, edged up to the leader in the far turn and failed to sustain bid in deep stretch. BOX OFFICE APPEAL stalked the pace in the backstretch, steadily gained position in the drive and was up for show at the wire. WYO GIRL stalked the pace in early stages, steadily gained position nearing the far turn and slightly weakened in the stretch. RATHER OUTSPOKEN saved ground racing along the inside and failed to threaten in the stretch. TAVA'S PRIZE settled in early stages, arced three wide in the far turn and lacked response in the drive. CLASS OF TWENTYTEN broke sharp from the gate, failed to maintain pace after opening quarter.
