DAWN RAIDER angled inwards while gaining a forward placing, stalked just off the leader to the backstretch, pressed that foe on the far turn and prevailed in the final stages under firm handling. SIR RABBIT tracked in second flight outside a rival in the opening half, bid three wide racing into upper stretch and just prevailed for the place. TIE ROD went readily to the fore, dueled for command along the rail to midstretch but weakened late. MR PLAYWRIGHT stalked just off the first flight racing along the rail to the far turn but came up empty in the drive. CANARD broke in hand, was settled along the inside and never mounted a serious challenge. CAPTAIN BUCKY, reserved racing off the inside in early stages, was caught four wide on the far turn and steadily faded from contention.
