Footnotes

CHARGING HOME tracked the pace in the backstretch, made a bid for the leader at the top of the lane, captured the lead in deep stretch and continued to clear to the wire. SATURDAY IN MAY asked ground along the inside in early stages, made a bid along the rail in the stretch and gained position to get up for second. BRAVO PRADO took command at the start, set the pace in the backstretch, continued the leader at the top of the lane, could not hold off rivals in final furlong and steadily weakened. WILLIE PREVAIL was reserved in early stages and gained position along the inside in the deep stretch. JIX raced five wide in the far turn and finished evenly in the deep stretch. PEAKS OF LEGEND stalked the pacesetters in the backstretch and came up empty in the drive. TIGERSTARK made a bid in early stages and had nothing left after half mile.
