Footnotes

NOBLEST REFLECTION, reserved saving ground in the opening half, switched out four deep after a half, made a steady advance to challenge three deep leaving the far turn, took charge in upper stretch and forged clear under steady encouragement. MADAME APPEAL was allowed to settle to the backstretch while saving ground, came off the inside to split foes racing into the lane and was just up for second. GRAND OIR tracked the leaders along the inside in second flight, dropped back nearing the far turn, then made an effort to improve her position in late stages. DANCE MINNALOUSHE was pulling hard against a rating hold in the opening half, joined the pace four deep after a half, bid for command entering the far turn but weakened once headed by the winner. MINNIE MILLIE tracked just off the first flight to the far turn, switched out nearing the lane but lacked the needed closing response. OTTOS LOTTO never seriously menaced. MISS APPROVAL was allowed to settle outside foes early and never gained contention. SARATOGA DANCER sprinted to the lead, dueled for command along the inside into the far turn and gave way entering upper stretch. SPANISH LIGHTNING was never a factor. SUNSHINE SURPRISE went up to join the pace outside a rival racing to the backstretch, then gave way on the far turn.
