Footnotes

HEZA WILD GUY raced in close attendance to the pace while three wide early, continued in that path while advancing to press the issue on the far turn, shook clear entering upper stretch, drifted inwards under pressure but widened his advantage. CONSIDER, reserved outside foes in the opening half, was fanned six wide racing into the lane, drifted inwards bumping TOP OF THE HEAP in the final stages but secured the place. ONOTHEREGOSTOKYO, shuffled back at the start, angled to the inside while making steady progress after a half, switched out entering the far turn to gain striking distance, couldn't gain terms with the winner in the drive and was outfinished for the place late. TOP OF THE HEAP tracked the leaders in hand racing just off the inside to the backstretch, advanced to contention while caught four wide on the second bend, then lost his momentum when bumped by a rival late. THRILL OF VICTORY raced unhurried outside foes in early stages, made a brief bid three or four deep between foes entering the far turn but lacked the necessary final response. A TEAM LEADER stalked just off the pacesetter between foes racing to the far turn but came up empty in the drive. WAYUPHI went up from the break to dictate the tempo along the rail, dueled for command on the far turn and emptied out in upper stretch. MR. SHOCK AND AWE was never a factor.
