**Footnotes**

TIGERSTARK second flight and on the rail, moved up on the two path through the second turn, took command into the stretch, then drew off under steady pressure through the lane. SWIFT PROGRESS mid pack and on the rail, moved up through the second turn, came three wide to bid into the stretch, drifted in, then angled out and closed fast late to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. LUVIN' GEORGE stalked the early pace outside, took command into the second turn, could not go with the winner into the stretch, stayed on and weakened in the late going. PENTECOST mid pack and inside, moved to position through the second turn, was blocked into the stretch, raced boxed through the stretch, angled in inside the eighth pole for clear racing room, then closed well to late. DOS ANGELS WARRIOR well placed and outside, came three wide to bid into the stretch and flattened out. IN FOR A SONG well back and inside, moved up through the second turn, steadied in the lane and faded. CHIEF I THIRTYFIVE improved his position. HARLEY D no factor. SLOW DOWN SONES set the early pace inside and stopped. SON OF ANNA was never involved.
