Footnotes

SKIP THE HATCHET mid pack and on the rail, moved to position through the second turn, came three wide to bid into the stretch, drifted out slightly into the stretch, then veered in at the eighth pole, drifted back out and got up. SHARP ANGLE vied for the early lead inside, shook loose into the stretch, then was outfinished. TAPINOT well back and off the rail, moved up on the two path through the second turn, angled out and bid four wide, then closed well and missed in the final strides. MUTAMENJA well back and inside, moved up through the second turn, came three wide to bid into the stretch and passed tiring rivals. BOOM BOOM MAGOO set the early pace outside and faded the final furlong. CRAFTY SCORE tracked the pace inside and had no stretch rally. GO GO CAT stumbled badly at the start and was no factor. BAD BOYZ HALO fractious in the gate, showed little. HALF MOUNTAIN CAT well placed and outside was through after a half.
