Footnotes

ROSE N ANGELINA attended the pace along the inside racing into the backstretch, took command midway through the far turn and made the balance of the pace under firm encouragement. BRICKTONA, allowed to settle along the inside in early stages, came through to challenge inside foes in the lane and secured second in time. SHADES OF HALO tracked the leaders unhurried in early stages, swung out four wide nearing the lane and continued to improve position. POTRITHREAT (ARG) tracked the pace outside a rival in second flight, bid three wide for command racing through the far turn but soon flattened out. GREETING CARD tracked the leaders along the inside early and passed some tiring rivals racing into the stretch. CHECK THIS OUT was hustled to the front, disputed the pace outside a rival and was spent after six furlongs. MANSTONE stalked the leaders along the inside to the backstretch but faded steadily from contention racing into the lane. FAIR MAGIC was never a factor. CHASE'N CAMMIE was outrun.
