MISCHIEF MO well back, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch, then made a steady gain and drew off the final furlong under brisk handling. DEAN DOESN'T KNOW vied for the early lead outside, moved up to challenge for and gain a clear lead through the second turn, could not go with the winner the final furlong, stayed on and held the place safe. PONIBOY TIME mid pack and off the rail, looped three wide through the second turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch and ran evenly the final furlong. PALMAS DEL MAR well placed and between rivals, moved to position through the second turn, angled out slightly to bid three wide and weakened the final furlong. TRUMPER passed tiring rivals. THE THIRD GUY set the early pace inside and faltered. BEAUASODA was a brief factor. CASINO CHARLEY well placed and off the rail, steadily lost ground. STRAITUPCASHOMEY was outrun.
