GRACEN RACEN tracked the early pace inside, angled out to bid four wide into the stretch, then made a steady gain, got clear late and held under steady pressure. BLUES EDGE well placed and outside, fanned widest into the stretch, then made a steady gain and got up for the place in the final strides while no threat to the winner. CINDER ELLIE vied for the early lead inside, gained a short lead into the turn, then shook clear into the stretch and was outfinished. CHILE WIN improved her position. SIFTEN GOLD NUGGET passed tiring rivals. WILD IN RIO vied for the early lead from between rivals, then faded in the drive. SOUPER FOUR set the early pace from between rivals, then faded at the head of the lane. CABOOSIAN LASS stalked the early pace four wide, angled in to bid three wide and stopped.
